

Fayetteville Town Council met in Special Session on November 14, 2019, at 5:00 p.m. at Town Hall.

Present were Mayor Sharon Cruikshank, Recorder Zenda Vance, Council Members Brian Good, Gabe Pena, Stanley Boyd, Lori Tabit, and Okey Skidmore. Also present were Town Attorney Carl Harris and Members of the Old High School Committee.

Mayor Cruikshank said the reason for the Special Session is to discuss with the Old High School Committee and Council options for old schools properties, walls and historic properties. Town Attorney Carl Harris said a Building Commission would need to be formed over the buildings in Town. It cost \$1,639 a month for equipment for heat in the Old Stone Building. Elementary Building needs work, roof is good. Old Stone Building won't work at Apartments.

Town Attorney Carl Harris said he could talk to Mark Sadd as the developer if Council and Committee wants him too.

Lita Eskew made a motion for Town Attorney Carl Harris to talk to Mark Sadd about all 3 buildings and bring back to Council and Committee and Ron DeWitt seconded the motion. Susan Hanson, Tommy Dickerson and Jim Akers approved the motion.

Mayor Cruikshank called to Order Special Council Meeting at 5:35 p.m.



Zenda Vance made a motion to donate \$500.00 toward the purchase of a new mat and Stanley Boyd seconded the motion. Okey Skidmore, Lori Tabit, Brian Good, and Gabe Pena approved the motion. Motion carries 8-0.


