Mayor Cruikshank said the Town needs to know what the Town is responsible for and be given the final cost for Council to make an informed decision.

Discuss and act on the sale/transfer of 2 police vehicles to another government agency. Chief Chapman said one model is a 2014 and the other one is a 2015. They both have over 100,000 miles and they don't make vehicles anymore and it's hard to get the parts. He would like to sell both for \$6,500 and one for \$4,500. Brian Good moved to approve and Gabe Peña seconded the motion. Stanley Boyd, Zenda Vance, Lori Tabit, and Okey Skidmore approved the motion. Motion carries 6-0.

Discuss and act on approval of 2023 Employee Handbook. There has been one correction made to it on Page 27 limitations on employee performance. Zenda Vance moved to approve, and Lori Tabit seconded the motion. Brian Good, Gabe Peña, Stanley Boyd, and Okey Skidmore approved the motion. Motion carries 6-0.
