

**Fayetteville Town Council met in Regular Session on October 16, 2025, at Town Hall at 6:00 P.M.**

**Present were Mayor Sharon Cruikshank, Recorder Zenda Vance, Council Members Okey Skidmore, Stanley Boyd, Lori Tabit (by zoom), Gabe Peña, and Brian Good. Also present were Town Attorney Carl Harris, Town Treasurer Kathy Williams, Fire Chief John Vernon, Chief of Police Ty Hogan, and Town Manager Matt Diederick.**

**Mayor Cruikshank offered prayer.**

**Mayor Cruikshank called the meeting to order.**

**Mayor Cruikshank led the Pledge of Allegiance.**

**Review and approval of financial report. Zenda Vance moved to approve and Brian Good seconded the motion. Motion carries 6-0.**

**General Comments and Reminders**

**Attorney Carl Harris said the trial for the appeal case last week, Officer Hannington did a great job and the Town won the case.**

**Mayor reminded everyone that Truck or Treat – October 31, 5:30-7:30 P.M. and Trick or Treat – October 31, 6-8P.M.**

**New Business**

**Discuss and act on opening bids for the Wolf Creek Dam Removal Sediment Sampling Study. One bid was received from ECS Mid-Atlantic, LLC for \$89,000. Gabe Peña moved to approve and Brian Good seconded the motion. Motion carries 6-0.**

**Discuss and act on 3<sup>rd</sup> party accounts to accept online payments. Town already has pay pal so there was no action taken.**

**Discuss and act on 2 new network printers for Town Hall - \$721 each for a total of \$1,442 from Quill. Okey Skidmore moved to approve and Zenda Vance seconded the motion. Motion carries 6-0.**

**Discuss and act on Service One Warranty Program partnership. Zenda Vance moved not to renew, and Stanley Boyd seconded the motion. Motion carries 6-0.**

**Discuss and act on paint estimate for council chambers. We have received one estimate so far for \$2,500 and it is for labor only. Gabe moved to approve up to \$2,500 and Brian Good seconded the motion. Motion carries 6-0. Mayor Cruikshank is checking with other people for estimates and will let council know.**

**Discuss and act on oak tabletop for council chambers - \$650 Lab Appalachia. Stanley Boyd moved to approve and Zenda Vance seconded the motion. Motion carries 6-0.**

**Discuss and act on partnership with Bearing Advisors. Council asked Matt to check with other Towns that are on the partnership and see how it is going with them. No action taken.**

**Discuss and act on Town Vehicle. Zenda Vance moved to approve, and Okey Skidmore seconded the motion. Motion carries 6-0.**

**Discuss and act on possible next steps or Town Signage. 10 Welcome banners were received today for the Town entrance. Stanley asked if there was any warranty if the signs fad. Matt said the Street Department guys can put the signs up. The total cost is \$49,074.25. Brian Good moved to approve to move forward with the signs and Gabe Peña seconded the motion. Motion carries 6-0.**

**Discuss and act on possible next steps for Town Engineer. Matt said we need an Engineer on call so some of the projects he is working on he will be able to call to see what the cost would be. Mayor Cruikshank said we should be able to call LL Robinson or Terradon at any time for them to look at the project. Carl said he didn't feel we needed to hire an Engineer to be on call as we can call one that Sharon mentioned for them to give us an estimate. If the project is over \$250,000, we will need to bid it out. No action taken.**

**Zenda Vance made a motion to go into Executive Session. Council went into Executive Session at 7:02 P.M. and reconvened at 7:33 P.M. with no decisions rendered.**

**Gabe Peña moved to adjourn.**

**Council adjourned the meeting at 7:33 P.M.**
